



# PROJECT PROFILE

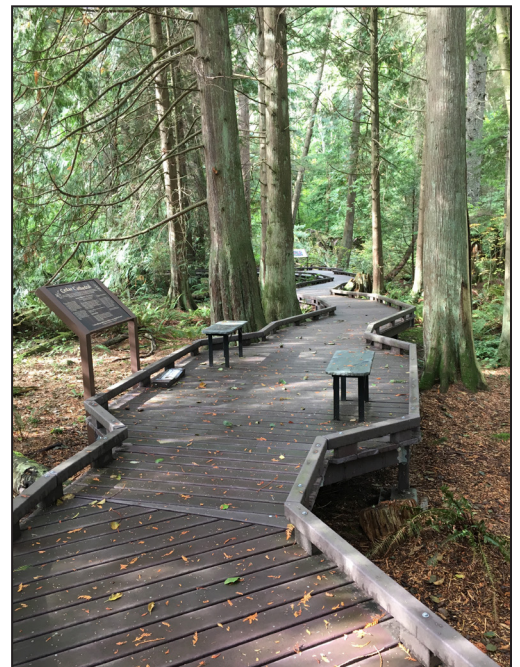
Northwest Stream Center is located on a beautiful 20-acre site in McCollum Park between Seattle and Everett, WA. Two salmon streams flow on the grounds that are covered with complex wetland systems and pockets of upland old second growth forest.

With this in mind, using recycled, environmentally conscious materials to construct a ½ mile elevated boardwalk was of utmost importance. Over 5,000 HDPE boards and 50,000 stainless steel screws went into making this exceptional project.

Towards the end of construction, the Snohomish County Planning Department Inspector paid a visit to examine the Elevated Nature Walk...he said that it was the best boardwalk that he had ever seen!
